Football Team

The Air Cavs Sports Club Football Team is self-supporting through registration, donations, and fundraising. The parents of the players sponsor the team.

Registration

The registration fee will be **\$200.00** for (1) player and **\$190.00** per player for siblings. You will be required to purchase a photo ID from the DMV, the cost is **\$14.00** and each child will need to have an up to date physical completed, signed, and stamped by a physician. Make checks payable to the Air Cavs Sports Club. The ***Registration fee is non-refundable.*** The **registration fee entitles your child the use of game and practice gear and must be returned at the end of the season. You will be responsible for items lost or damaged.** The average cost to outfit a player in a safe and appropriate uniform would cost around **\$300.00.** **Your registration fee would also purchase additional accidental insurance for your child.**

A player registration form must be completed and returned immediately. Your child will not be able to practice if the form is not completed and returned. We will not issue any equipment as well. All players who have not played with the Air Cavs Sports Club must bring a copy of their birth certificate before he or she is considered eligible to play.

Coaches

The coaches for the teams have over 80 years of experience in football. They will do everything to ensure that all children are conditioned and taught to perform in a safe manner. Any persons interested in coaching must see Rhonda Graham, complete an online background check (**\$10.00**), complete the USA Football Youth Certification, and be cleared through the CCYFL. This will also apply to any adult on the sideline for practices or games (water boy, trainers, etc.). No exceptions.

Practice

Practices are generally scheduled Monday-Thursday from 5:30 p.m. to approximately 7:00 p.m. but may change depending on games or weather conditions. Typically, there is no practice on Wednesdays, but this is subject to change and may include an occasional Saturday practice as well. Our official practices will begin **Monday, July 31st** at **Broadview Middle School**. We ask all parents or guardians to remain on the outer boundaries of the practice areas and not disrupt the practice. Any violators will be asked to leave. It is important that parents be aware of the time practice will end and be there to pick up your child (**parents should return by 6:30 PM**). It is most important that children attend practice daily to know what to do during game situations. If they don't attend practice expect less playing time unless your reason is justifiable. Please notify one of the coaches if your child is going to miss practice. ***Please do not come to practice or game if you did not attend school. In case of rain or showers, parents please plan to bring your child to practice or games unless a message is sent through TeamReach. If conditions are unfavorable to practice or play the game, you will be dismissed to leave.***

Teams

We will have a 6U, 8U, 10U and 12U team and each team will need **four** Team Parents to help organize the special events for their team.

Their duties include collecting uniforms, checking attendance daily at the practice field, passing out memos to team members and parents, helping to pass out equipment, calling parents to inform them of any changes, and any other duties requested by the coaches.
